

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMAS

Postgraduate Diploma Courses and 12 Calendar months Full-Time Degree Programmes are available.

A. Postgraduate Diplomas:

These are available in Anaesthesia, Applied Geophysics, Guidance and Counselling, Computer Science, Accounting, Chemical Engineering, Education, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Environmental Management, Manpower Economics and Planning, Mechanical Engineering, Metallurgical and Materials Engineering, Environmental Design, Philosophy, Surveying and Geoinformatics, Mathematics (Full-Time), Mass Communication (Full-time and Part-time), Theater Arts, Visual Arts and Music, NetTel(a)Africa PGD (ICT) (Policy and Regulations), Building and Civil Engineering.

ELIGIBILITY FOR POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMAS/MASTERS BY COURSEWORK

General Requirements

An applicant for admission to a programme shall be:

- (i) a holder of an honours degree of this University or other recognized University;
- (ii) a person who holds other qualification(s) approved by Senate;
- (iii) notwithstanding (a) and (b) above, an applicant may be required, as a condition for admission, to undergo a selection process.

Candidates who have not completed the National Youth Service Corps assignments or their current Postgraduate programmes need not apply. Such applicants will be automatically disqualified.

Candidates awaiting Bachelor's degree results need not apply.

All academic transcripts must reach the Secretary, School of Postgraduate Studies on or before the beginning of registration.

Special Requirements

Some Departments have specific requirements for admission. Candidates are therefore advised to contact the Departments of their choice or consult the Postgraduate School Prospectus for further information.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR DIPLOMA PROGRAMMES

1. Postgraduate Diploma in Anaesthesia

Basic Degree in Medicine (MB, BS or MD) or (MB. Ch.B).

Pre-Registration Internship - 1 year rotation in Medicine, Obs & Gynaecology, Surgery and Paediatric.

Registration with Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria (MDCN).

NYSC or Exemption Certificate is compulsory.

2. Postgraduate Diploma in Computer Science (Part-Time /Evening Programme)

This programme shall be open to:

- (i) Candidates having a Bachelor's degree with honours or its equivalent in Mathematics, Statistics, Physics, or Engineering of this or any other approved University,
- (ii) Candidates having at least a Second Class lower Division in the Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in Chemistry, Biology, Economics, Business Administration or any science-related subject of this or any other approved University,
- (iii) Candidates will be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process.

3. Postgraduate Diploma in Education (PGDE)

Holders of honours degrees in appropriate Arts, Science and Social Science subjects are eligible to apply.

4. Postgraduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling (Part-Time)

Candidates must possess a first degree in any discipline obtained from University of Lagos or any other recognized institution.

Candidates must show evidence that they have completed their NYSC programme or produce evidence of exemption. Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process before admission.

5. Postgraduate Diploma in Mass Communication (Full-Time and Part-Time)

Only holders of honours degrees in disciplines other than Mass Communication and Journalism are eligible to apply.

6. Postgraduate Diploma in Manpower Economics and Planning

Holders of honours degrees in Social Science, Engineering, Pure and Applied Sciences or honours degrees in other Disciplines with strong quantitative background are eligible to apply.

7. Postgraduate Diploma in Philosophy

- (i) Candidates with a Bachelor's degree (Honours) in any discipline from the University of Lagos or any other University may apply for admission into the programme.
- (ii) Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process before admission.
- (iii) Candidates are required to satisfy all other requirements of the Postgraduate School.

8. Postgraduate Diploma in Civil and Environmental Engineering (Part-Time)

Candidates must have a first degree with honours in Engineering, Building, Mathematics Physics, Geology, Computer Science or other allied disciplines.

Duration: 2 Sessions

9. Postgraduate Diploma in Chemical Engineering

- (i) The programme, which is part-time, will last for three academic semesters and admission shall be open to candidates with Bachelor's degrees with honours in Engineering other than Chemical Engineering, the Physical

Sciences i.e. Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, and also in Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Food Science and Technology, and Geology.

(ii) Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process.

10. **Postgraduate Diploma in Electrical and Electronics Engineering with specialization in areas of Electrical Power, Electronics, Communication and Control.**

This programme is part-time and is to last for 24 calendar months.

Admission Requirements:

Candidates for admission into the PGD (Electrical and Electronics Engineering) programme are required to have:

- (i) a first degree with honours in any field of Engineering other than Electrical and Electronics Engineering;
- (ii) a first degree with honours in Physics, Computer Sciences, Mathematics or any of the allied courses.

Candidates who are *prima-facie* qualified under these requirements may be required to satisfy the Department in a qualifying/selection examination.

11. **Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) Applied Geophysics**

- (i) Open to Candidates who possess a Bachelor's degree with honours in Physical Sciences or Engineering of this University or any other approved institution.
- (ii) Available options are (a) Exploration Geophysics and Environmental Geophysics

Available options are Exploration Geophysics and Environmental Geophysics.

12. **Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in Economics (Part-Time)**

Candidates are required to possess a first degree with honours from any discipline preferably with quantitative background in Statistics and Basic Mathematics from a recognized University. In addition, all candidates may be required to fulfill a specified standard in an entrance examination or interview for selection.

13. **Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in Building Services (Full-Time)**

Bachelor's degree with honours in Building, Architecture, Engineering (Civil, Mechanical or Electrical), Quantity Surveying, Physics, Estate Management, Urban and Regional Planning and Mathematics.

14. **Postgraduate Diploma in Metallurgical and Materials Engineering**

Open to candidates who possess a first degree with honours from any field of Engineering or in any field in the Physical Sciences, e.g. Physics, Computer Sciences, Mathematics etc.

15. Postgraduate Diploma in Environmental Design (PGDED) (Part-Time)

- (i) First degree in Architecture, Urban and Regional Planning, Estate Management, Quantity Surveying, Surveying, Fine Arts, Economics, Forestry and Horticulture with honours or its equivalent from this or any other recognized University.
- (ii) Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in the selection process before admission.
- (iii) Candidates are expected to satisfy all other requirements of the School of Postgraduate Studies, University of Lagos.

16. Postgraduate Diploma in Surveying and Geoinformatics (Full-Time)

The course is open to Candidates with any of the following qualifications:

- (i) First Degree with honours in Engineering and Physical Sciences as well as Geography with Mathematics from a recognized University.
- (ii) Master of Geoinformatics of the University of Lagos or any other recognized Institution
- (iii) Candidates with Masters degree in Geographic Information System (MGIS) of the University of Lagos or any other recognized Institution.

Notes

Candidates with qualifications in (ii) and (iii) above will have to make up for deficiencies in Mathematics and Physics.

Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process before admission.

17. Postgraduate Diploma in NetTel@Africa (PGD) ICT Policy and Regulations

Candidates are required to possess a good honours degree in any of the disciplines in Engineering, Physical Sciences, as well as Geography, Sciences, Business Administration, Arts and Law of the University of Lagos; a graduate in any of the same discipline of any of NetTel's partner Universities, or any other University recognized by the University of Lagos. Candidates might be required to satisfy the host Department in a selection process.

18. Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in the following areas in Creative Arts:

- (a) Theatre Arts
- (b) Visual Arts
- (c) Music

(a) Theatre Arts

- (i) Candidates with Bachelor's degree with honours in other disciplines (except Theatre Arts or Creative Arts) from the University of Lagos or any other approved University may apply for admission into this programme.
- (ii) Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process before admission.
- (iii) Candidates are also expected to satisfy all other requirements of the School of Postgraduate Studies.

(b) Visual Arts

- (i) Candidates with Bachelor's degree with honours in other disciplines (except Visual Arts or Creative Arts) from the University of Lagos or any other approved University may apply for admission into the programme.
- (ii) Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process before admission
- (iii) Candidates are also expected to satisfy all other requirements of the School of Postgraduate Studies.

(c) Music

- (i) Candidates with Bachelor's degree with honours in other disciplines (except Music or Creative Arts) from the University of Lagos or any other approved University may apply for admission into this programme.
- (ii) Candidates may be required to satisfy the Department in a selection process before admission.
- (iii) Candidates are also expected to satisfy all other requirements of the School of Postgraduate Studies.

19. Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in Accounting (Full-Time and Part-Time)

Bachelor's degree with Honours in Accounting Related Disciplines from this or any other approved University. Such other related disciplines include: Business Administration, Banking and Finance, Management, Economics, Insurance and Actuarial Science.

20. Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in Building Services (Full-Time)

- (i) At least a B.Sc degree with honours in Architecture, Building, Estate Management, Urban and Regional Planning, Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Surveying, Physics and Mathematics
- (ii) Any other equivalent qualification approved by the University
- (iii) In addition, an applicant may be required as a condition of admission to undergo a selection process.
- (iv) All applicants must satisfy other admission requirements of the School of Postgraduate studies.
